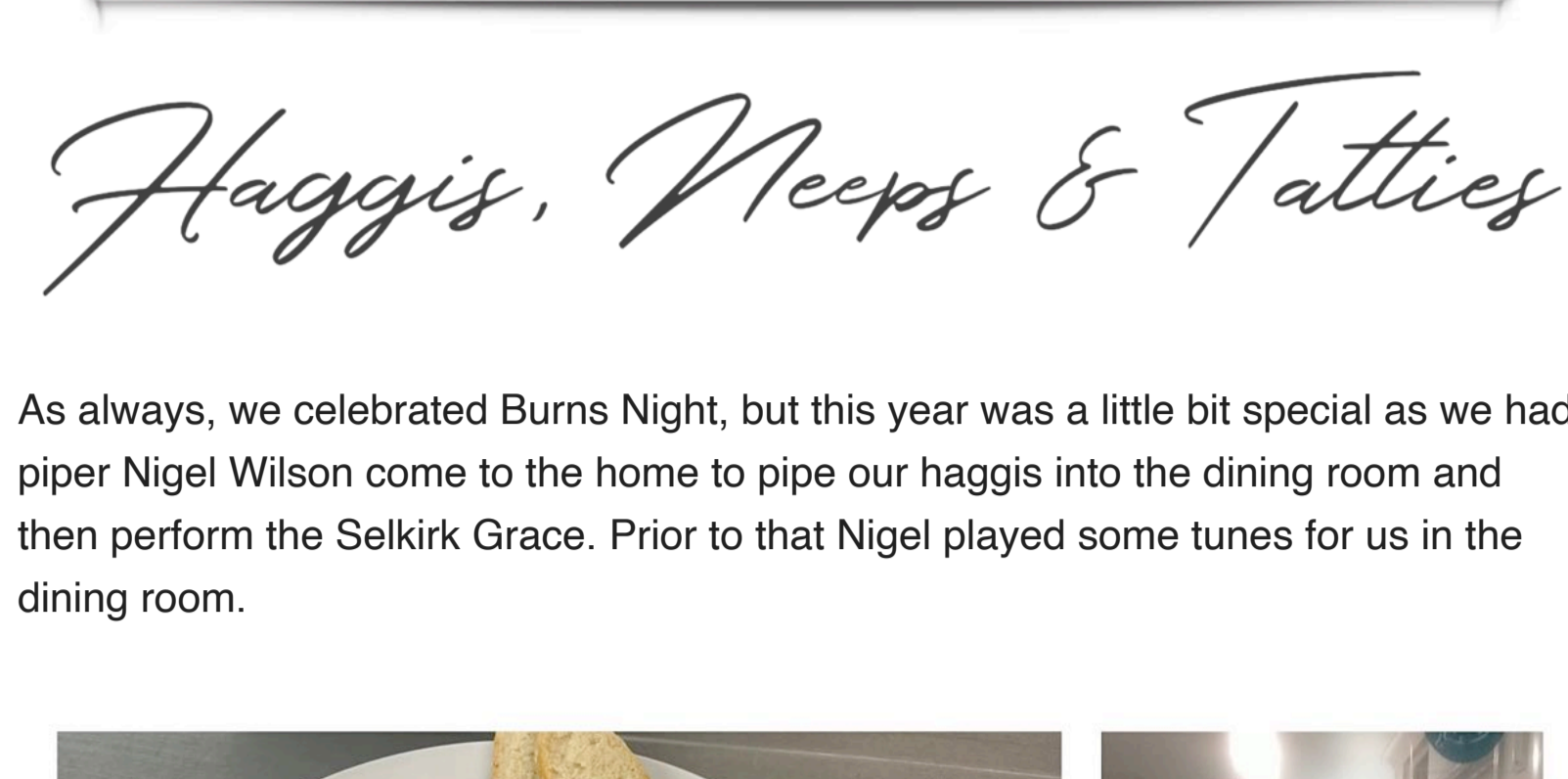

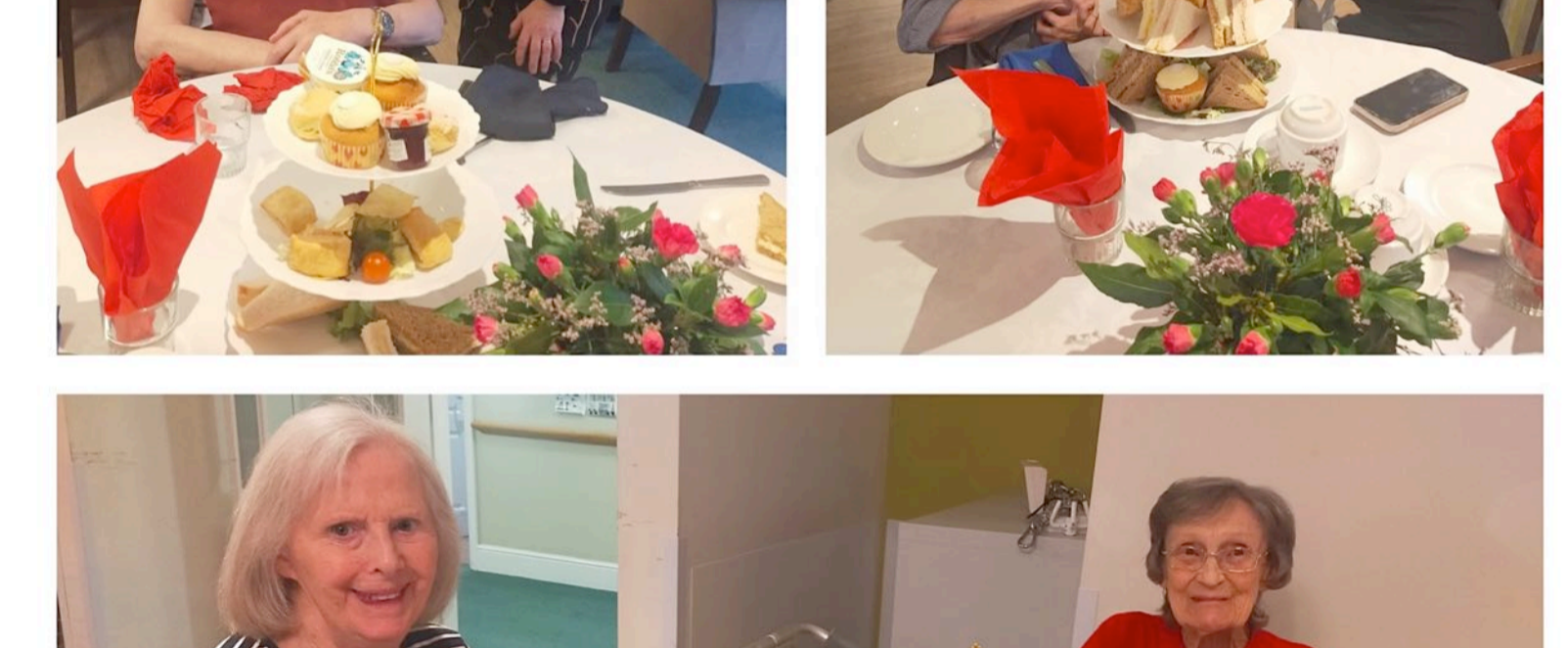


Valentines Day

Straight after Pancake Day, we had Valentines Day and this year we invited our residents loved ones to come and join us for Valentines Afternoon Tea.



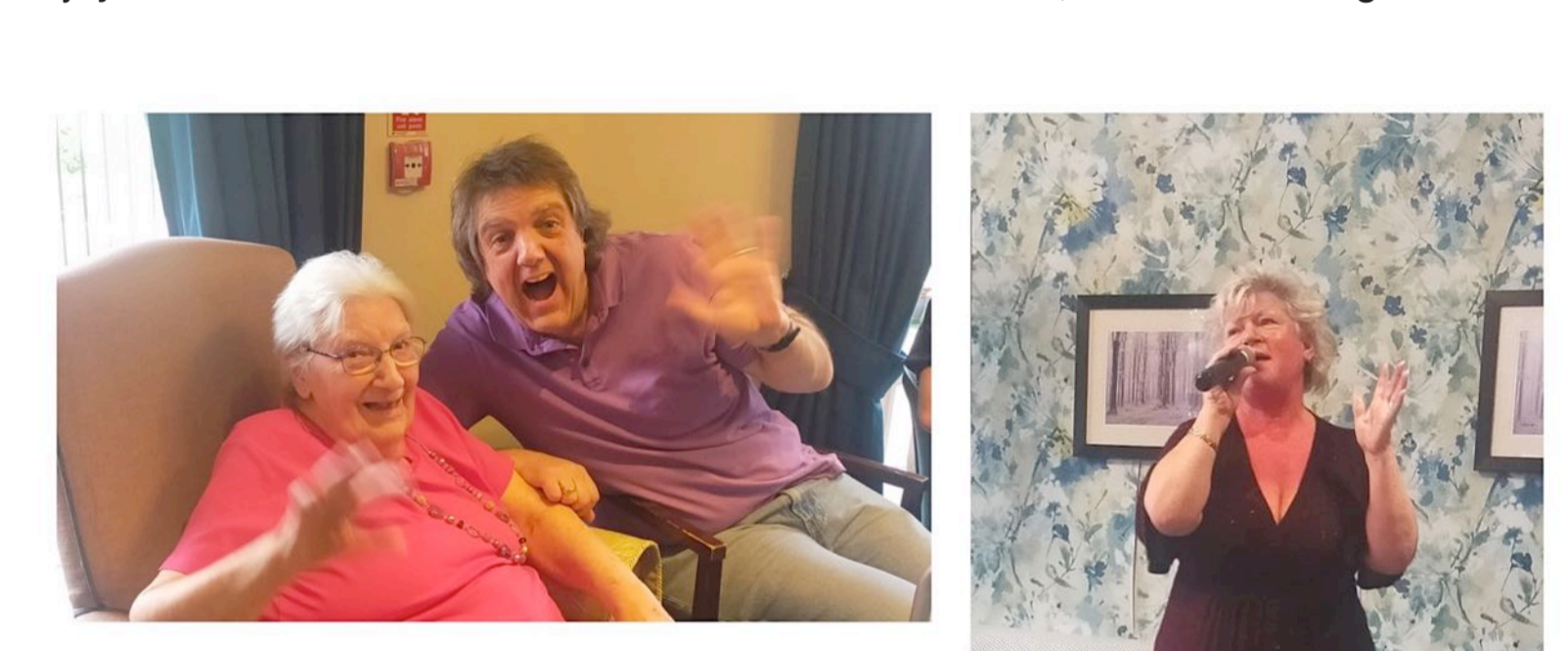
Two of our residents, Jill and Cynthia enjoying afternoon tea together.

Mother's Day

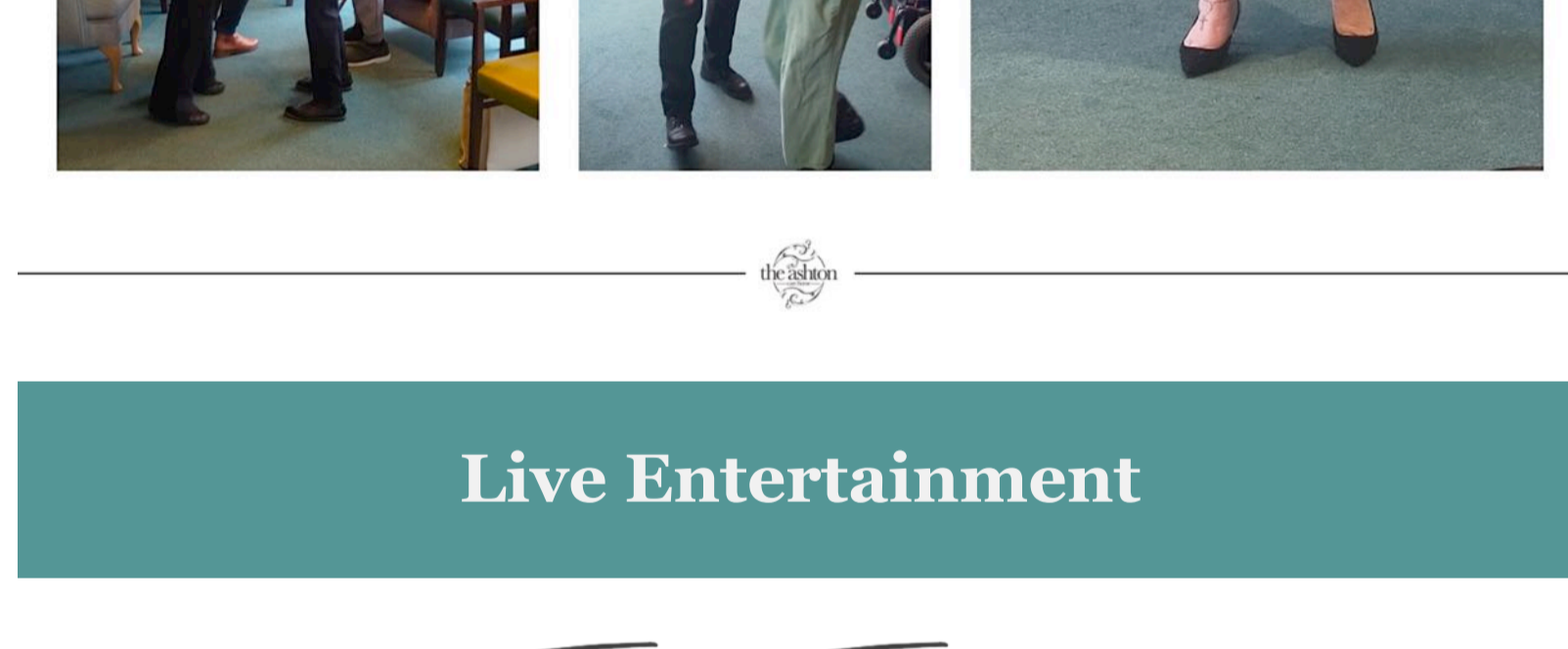


Happy Times!

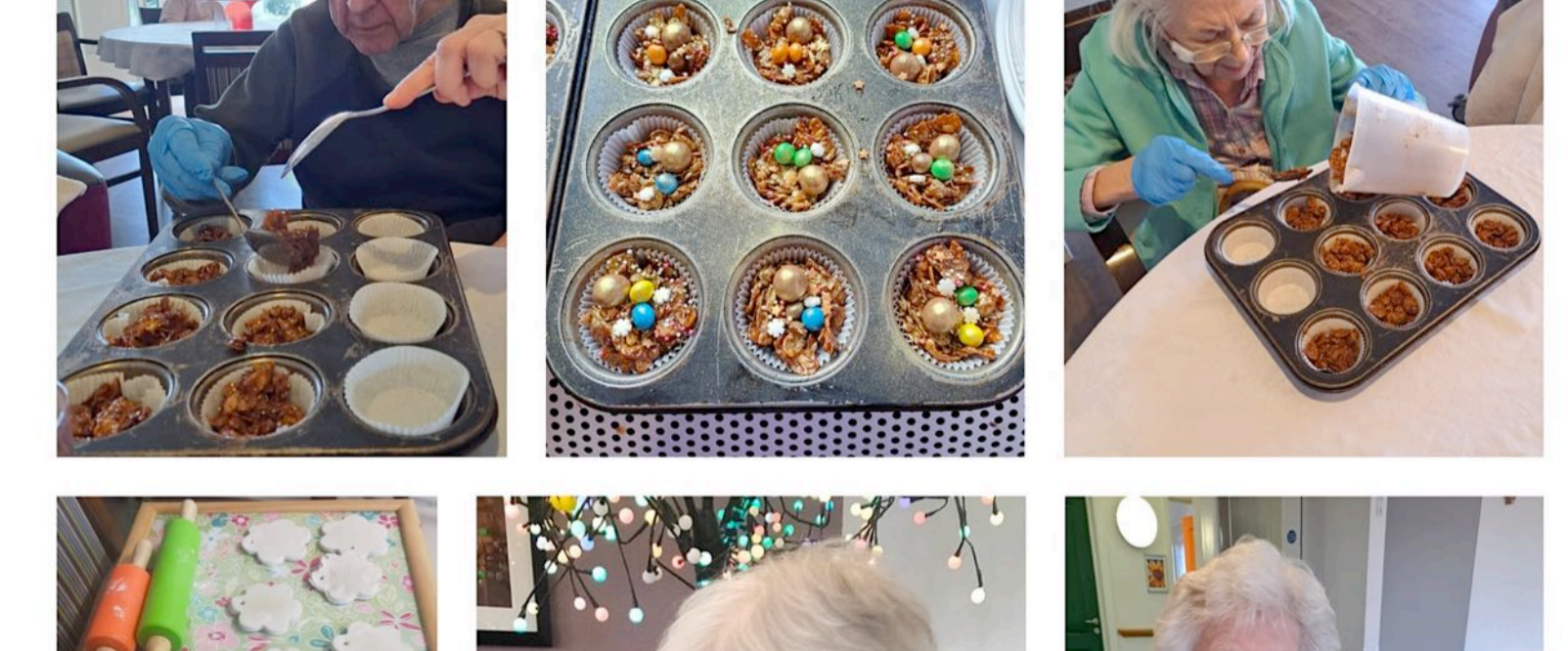

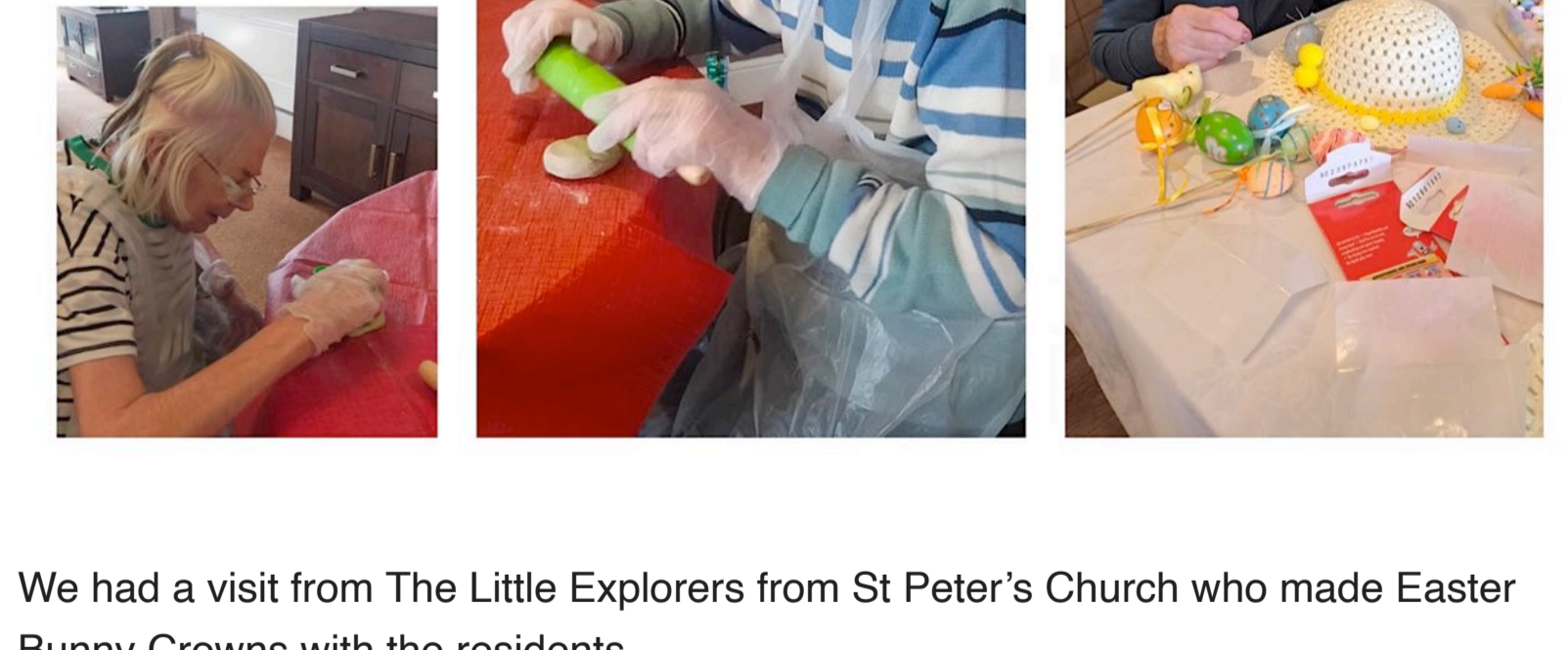


Creative Creations

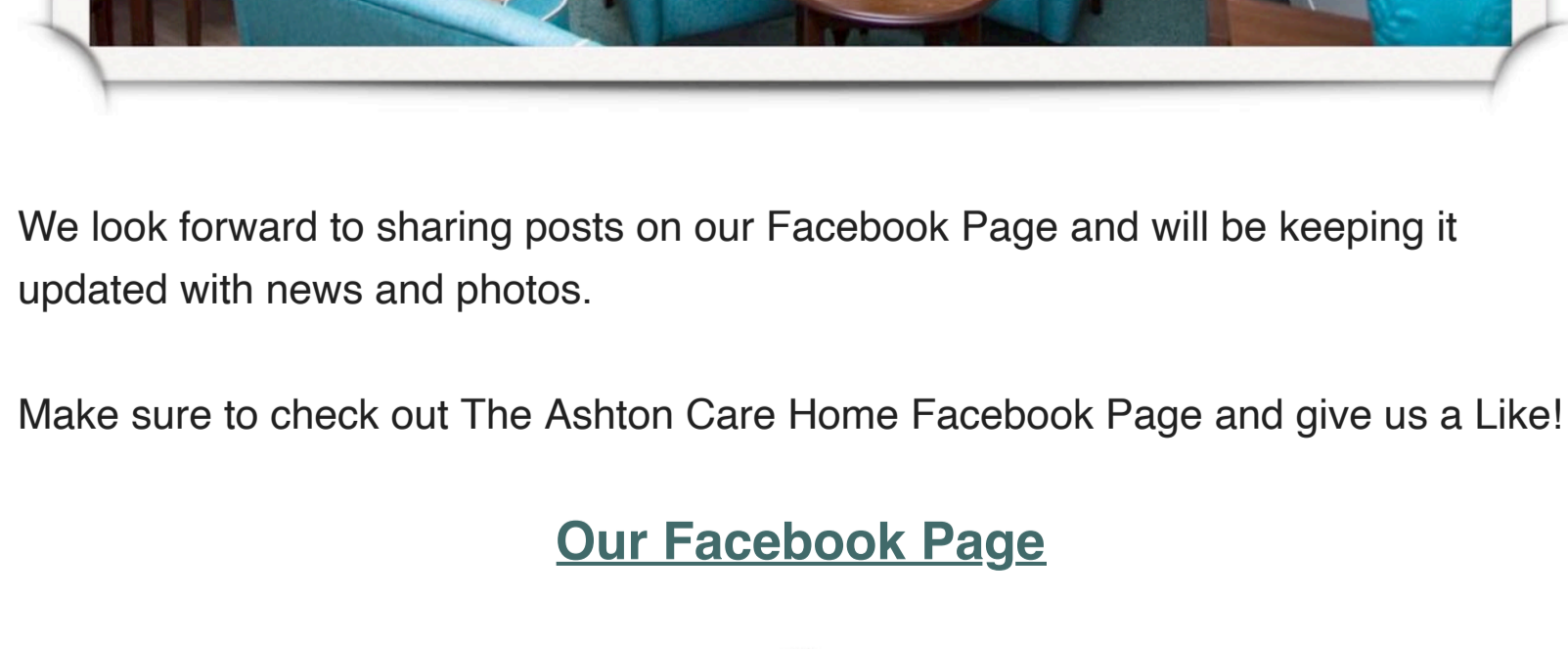
