Manager's Introduction

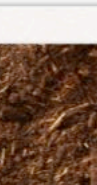

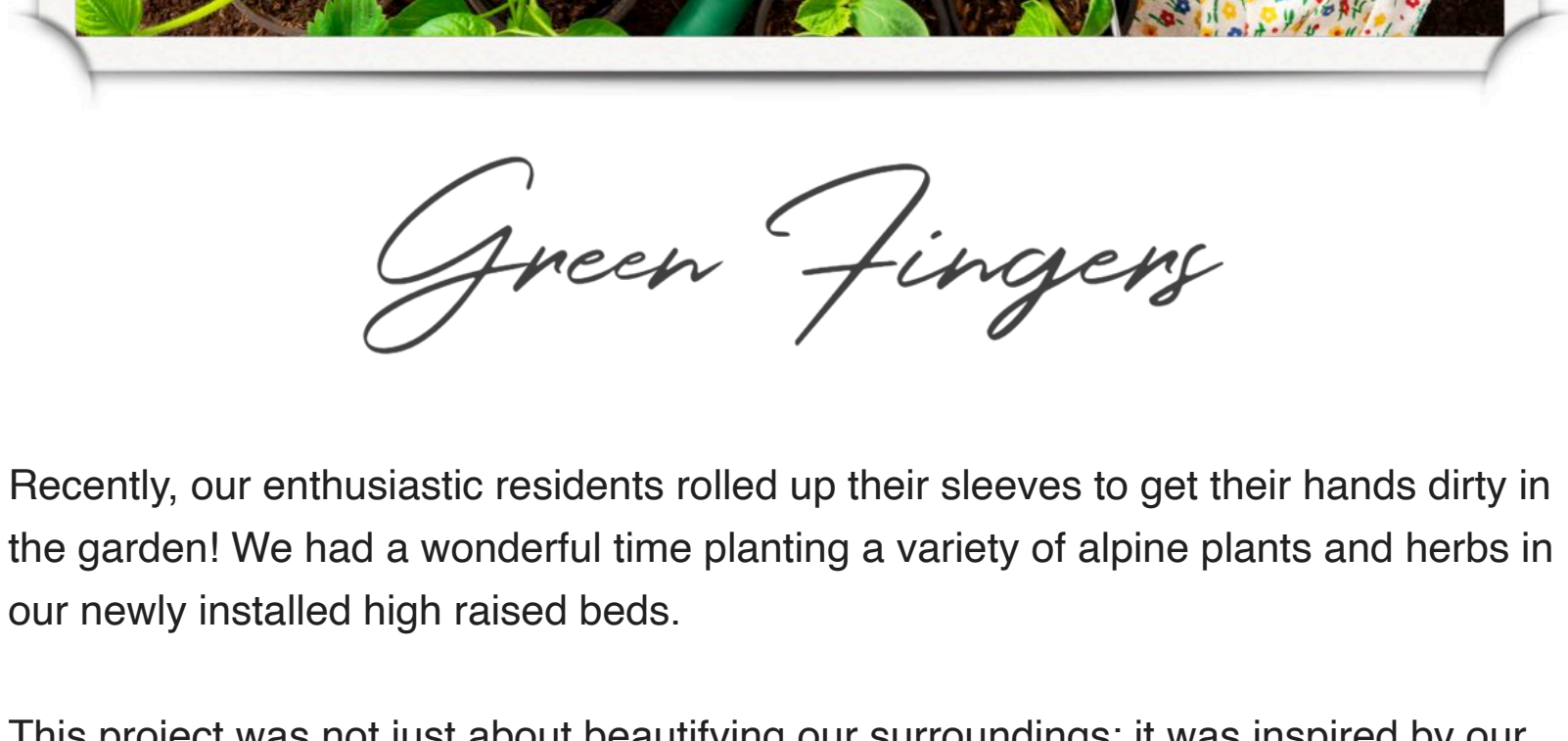

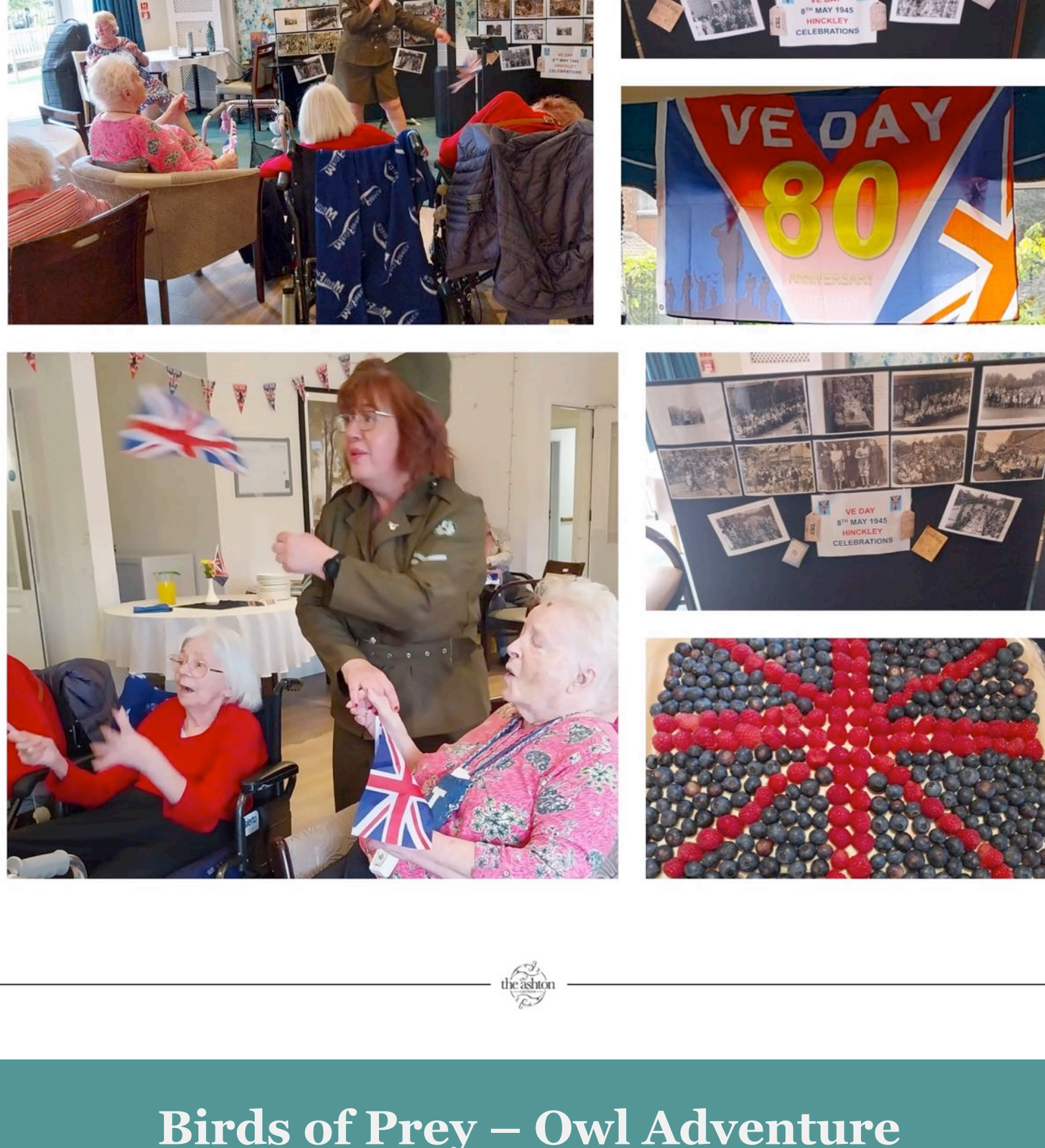


VE Day

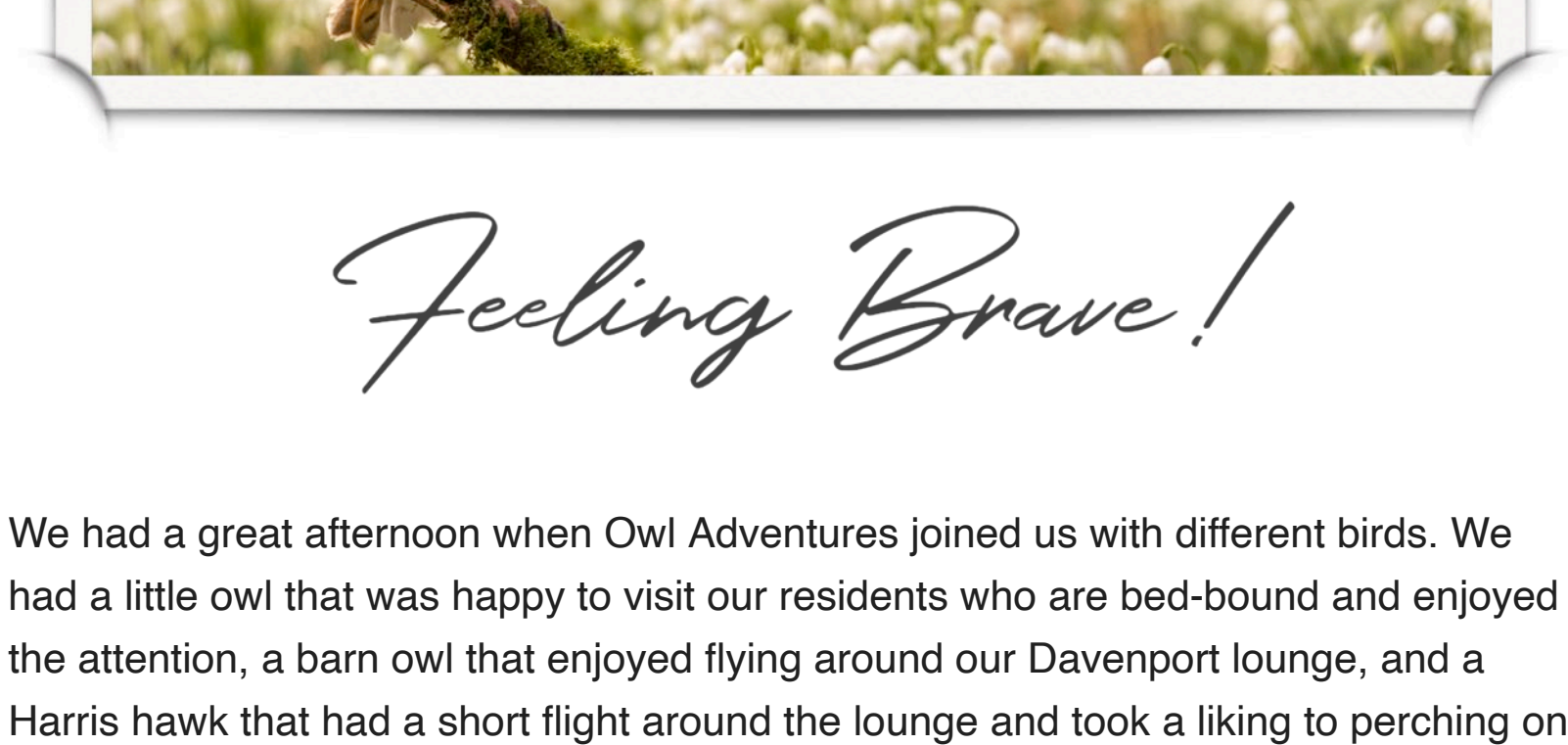


Meaningful Activities

Birds of Prey – Owl Adventure

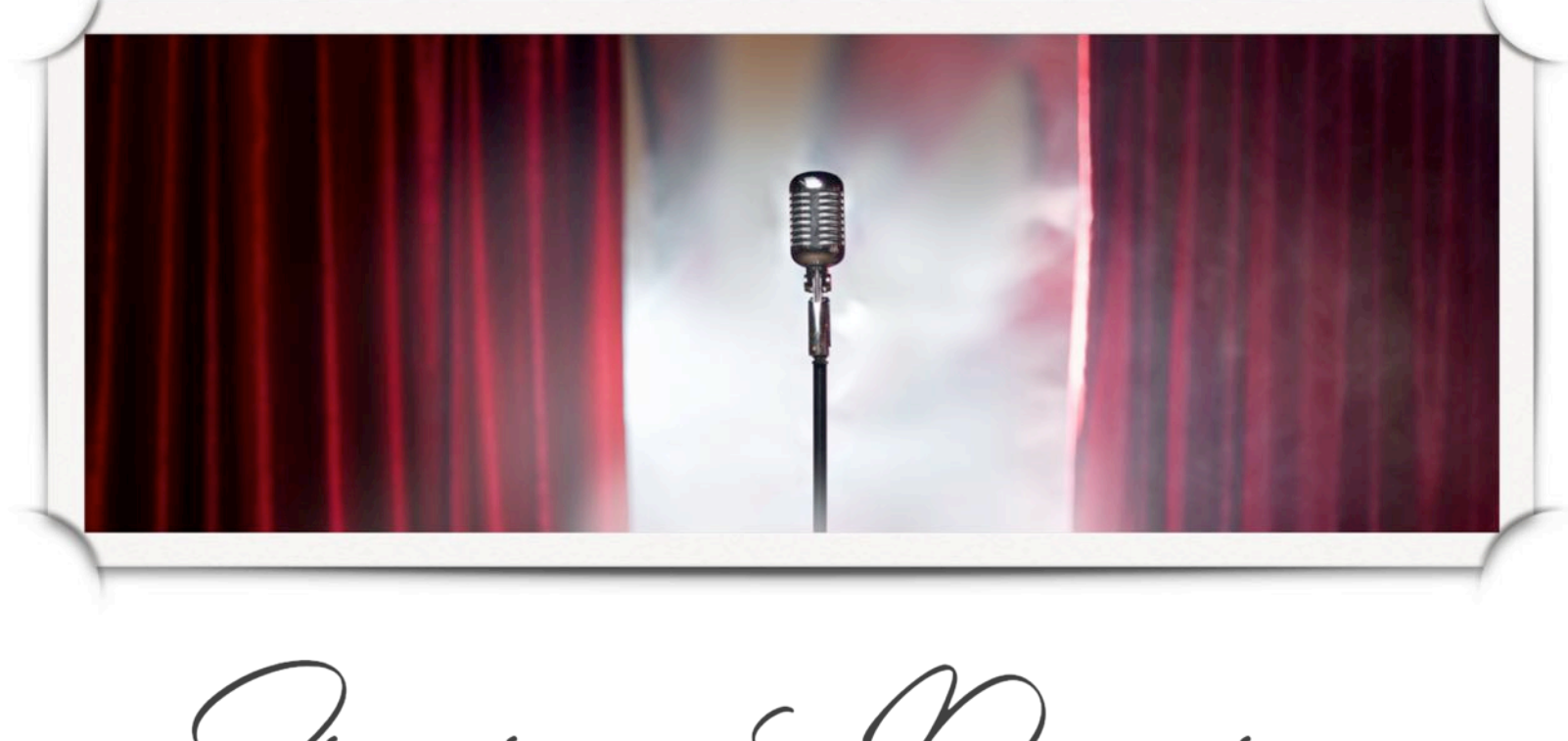


Feeling Brave!

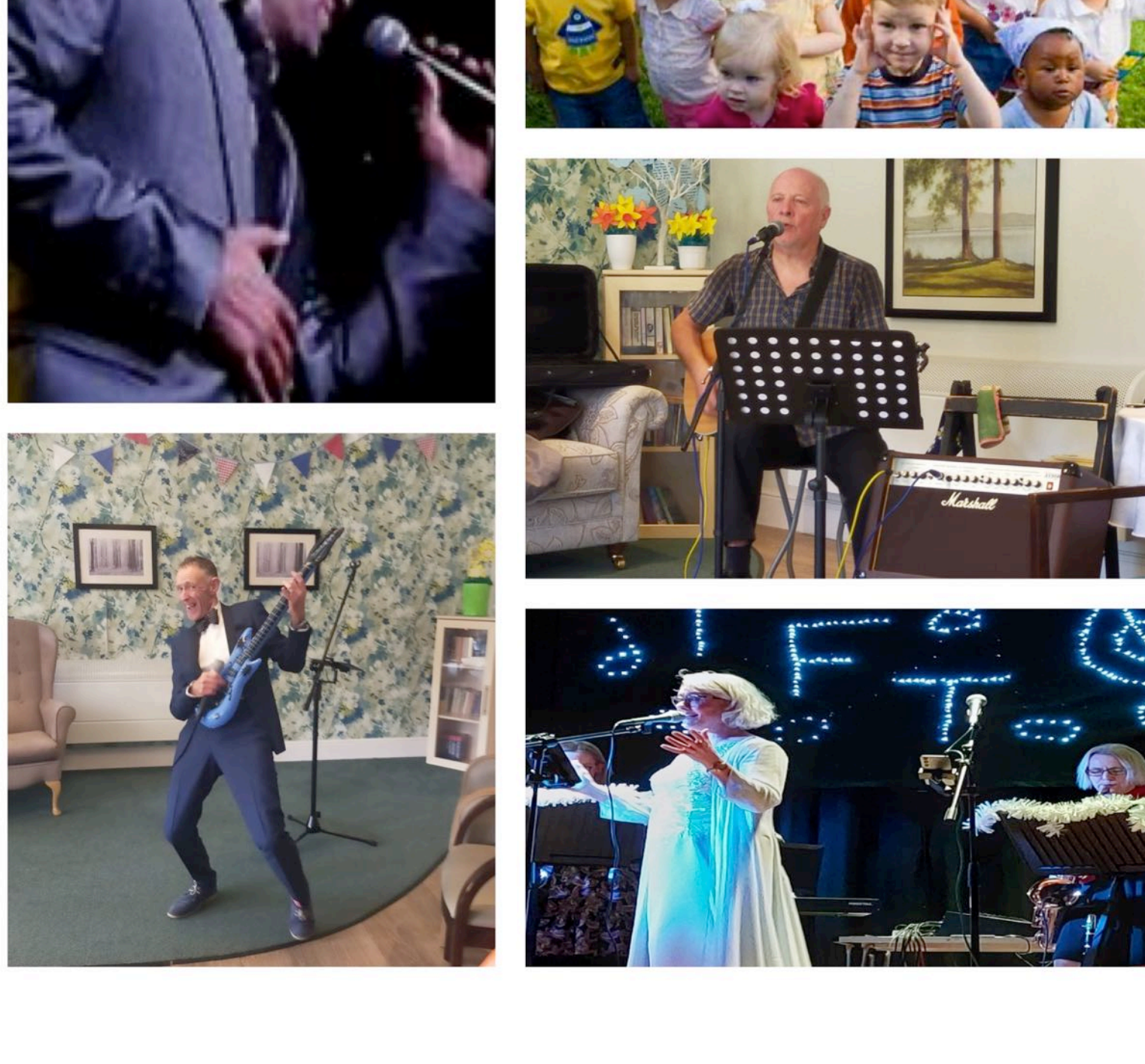

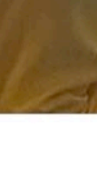


Singing & Dancing

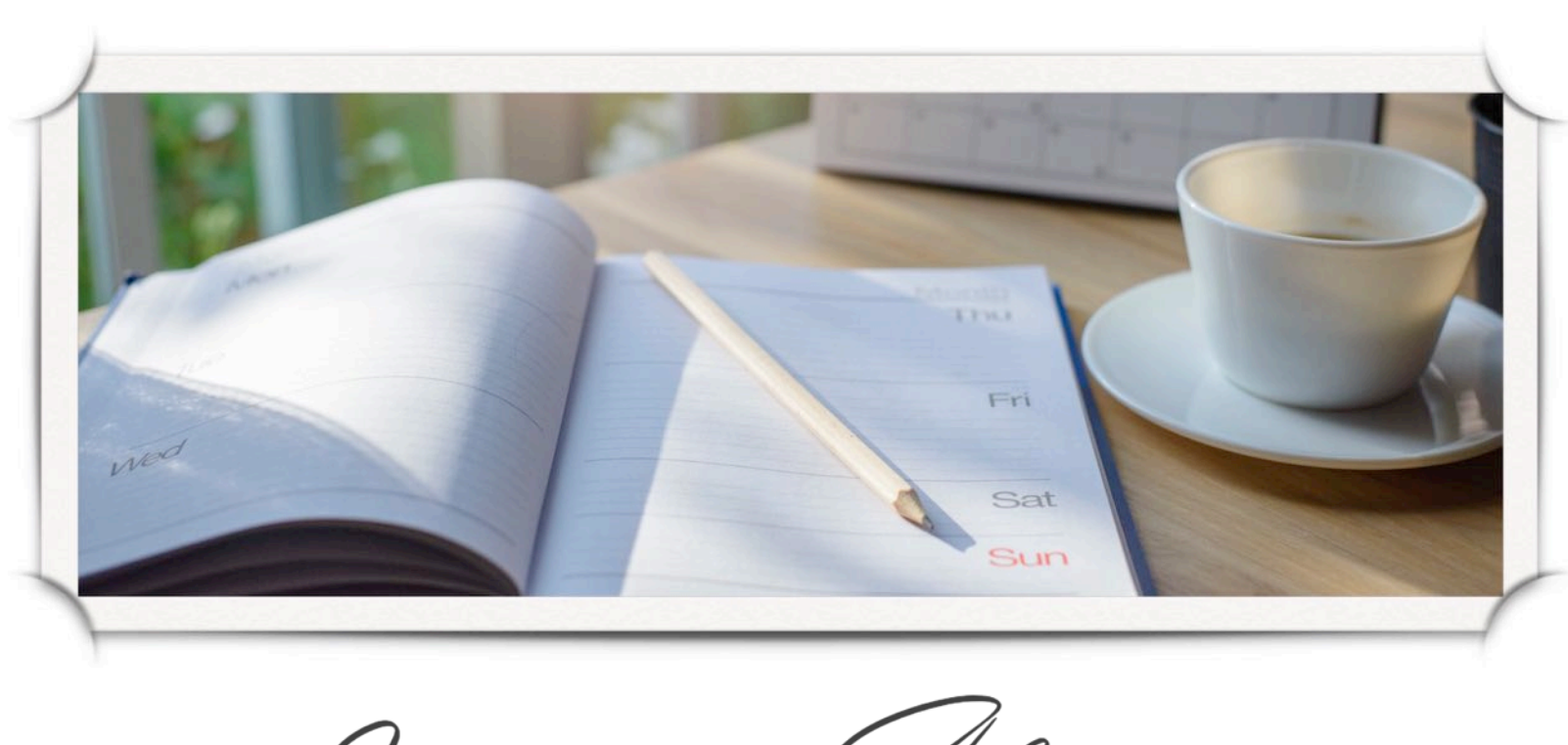

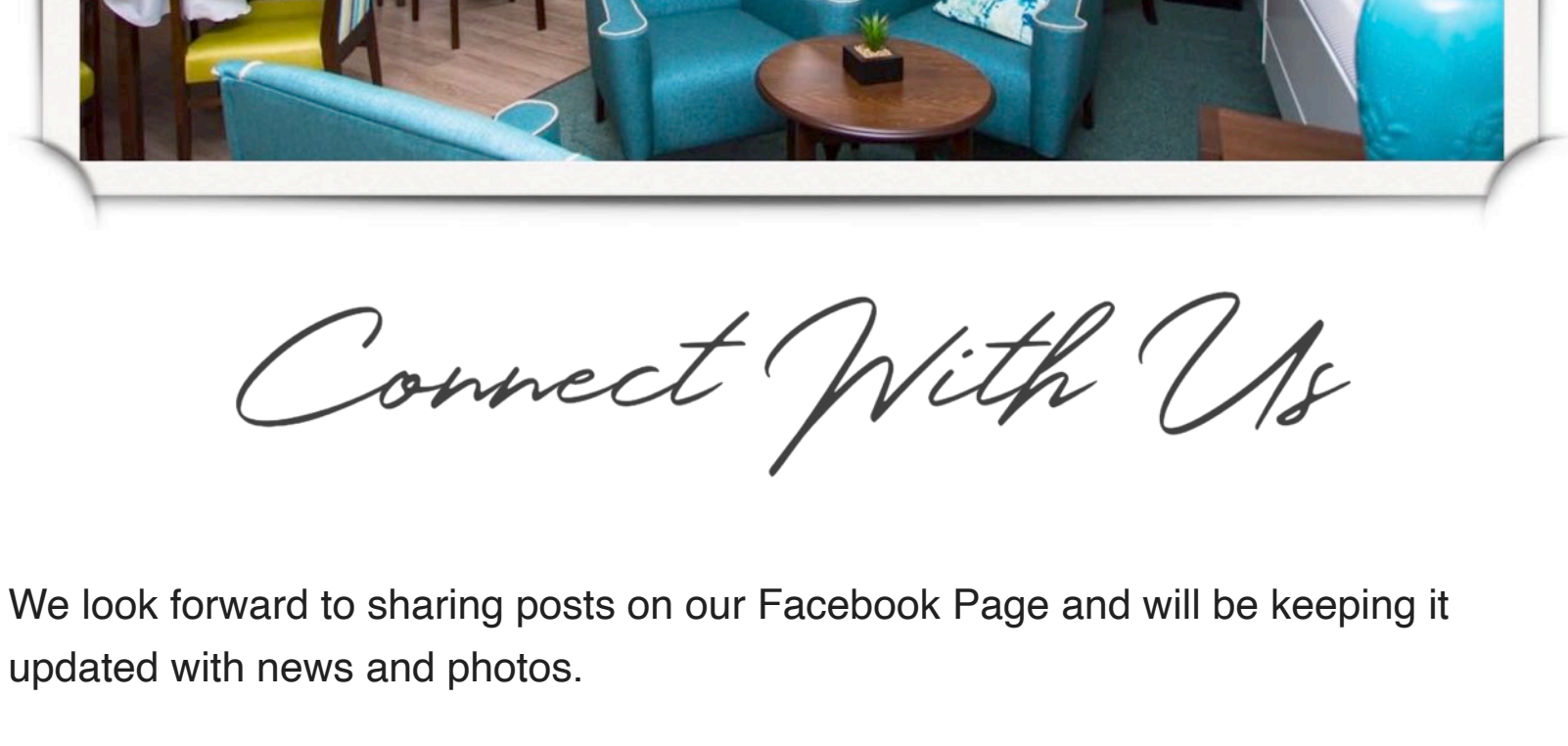

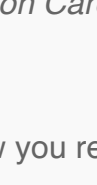
